

Car TOP HANDRAILS

Elevator car top handrails are installed on the top of existing cabs as shown in Fig. 1 below. This addition provides a safe and secure working environment for technicians and licensed professionals to access components and trouble-shoot issues when necessary. In addition to safety, this update decreases a building's liability exposure.

LEGISLATION

States are adopting codes in-line with OSHA standards with regards to the installation of car top handrails to provide added building safety. For example, the state of Washington code states the following:

“A standard railing must be installed on the top of all traction elevators where the perpendicular distance between the edges of the car top and the adjacent hoistway enclosure exceeds twelve inches horizontal clearance... WAC 296-96-23119.”

Car Top Emergency Exit

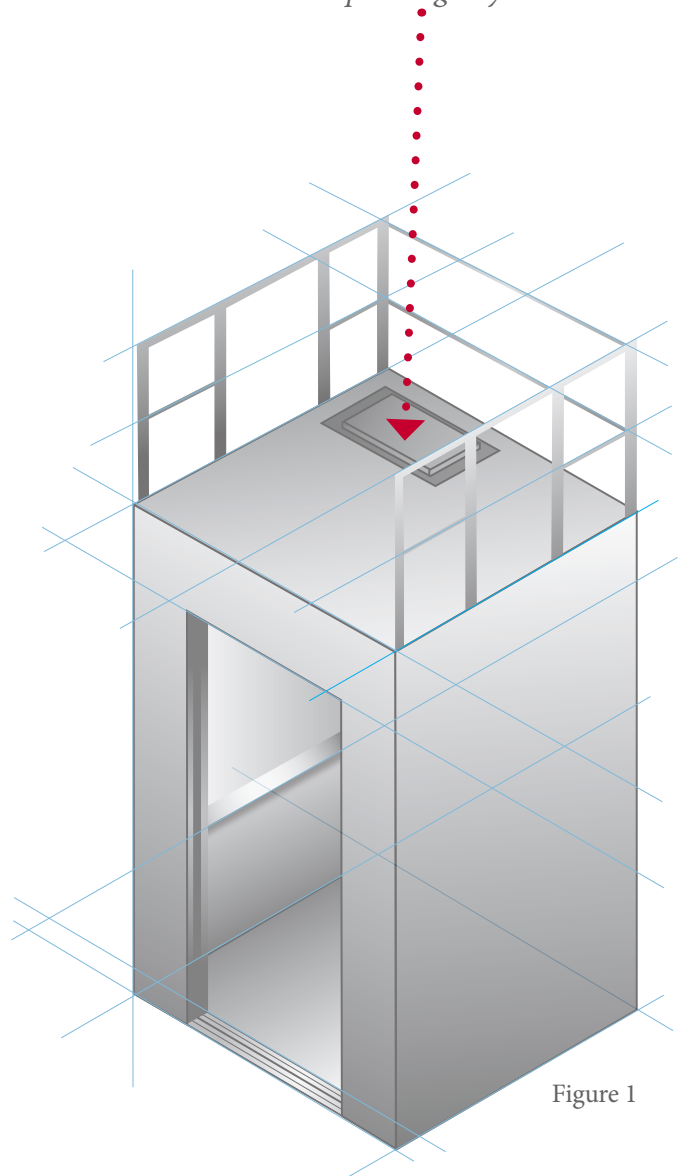
